3. Matters arising from the minutes:

Flooding in Milton was discussed on the previous minutes. Councillor Steel will liaise with the Milton residents and report any issues to the Flooding Committee.

4. Any Other Business

No further issues seen with anti-social behaviour around the Foremark reservoir.

A resident representing the Village Party which is assisting in organising the Jubilee celebrations advised they wish to have the climbing wall at the Village Party, which is to be held on the Friday of the Jubilee weekend. He wished the Council to consider if they could become involved with the decoration of some of the houses. County Councillor Martyn Ford advised he can offer a small amount of funding. The Council asked if the Jubilee Committee could present a proposal for funding and bring back to the Council.

A resident asked for funding of approximately £515 for equipment for the community speed watch group. They can only operate in 30mph or 40mph areas. They currently have 6 volunteers who have received their police training. The first approved location for the speed watch is on Burton Road, Repton. They may approve other locations in the future. Speeding is still happening but the parking along the Main Street in Milton does slow some traffic down. Milton would like to be involved in the community speed watch.
